Guidelines to conduct Remedial Teaching for Learning Enhancement of students studying in class 9th

For conducting remedial teaching, follow the following guidelines:

- Remedial classes for 9th class will be organised w.e.f 1st Sept., 2016 to 28th Oct, 2016. The remedial classes for one hour per day before/after the school hours for 45 days (15 days for each subject) to be organized in the schools.
- Two days per week are to be assigned for each specified subject (i.e. 2 days for Math, 2 days for Science and 2 days for English).
- The additional coaching in Math, Science and English subjects is to be imparted.
- The classes are to be organised for low achiever of 8th class pass out students that may be of any grade(i.e. 'A' or 'B' or 'C' or 'D' or 'E') who are at present studying in 9th class
- The syllabus of 8th class that are the basics for 9th class will be taught. **The tentative course to be taught is enclosed along with as attachment for your ready reference.**
- In the beginning of the remedial classes baseline test will be taken in the supervision of school head where the remedial teaching will be conducted.
- In the beginning and at the end of the remedial classes a test will be conducted and administered by the school head for which an assessment tool/question papers for the three subjects of 30 marks each shall be prepared by the schools. To prepare test tool and conduct baseline and endline test, there is budget provision of Rs 250/-per school.
- The head and SMC person will supervise the learning enhancement programme of the School.
- Peer group learning should be adopted in the process of remedial teaching.
- The requisite amount for conducting remedial classes will be remitted very soon as per guidelines.
- Depute the concerned subject teachers of the subjects Science, Mathematics & English of the school for this purpose. In case of vacancy, PGT/Lecturer or some qualified person from nearby community may be hired for the purpose. He/she will be made responsible so that each low performing student come up to desired standard. **Submit the list of deputed teacher's along with mobile no to the undersigned immediately.**
- Honorarium @Rs 2000/- per subject may be given in each of three subjects.
- The School Head will submit the report on attached **Annexure A** along with UC of remedial grant.
